# June 16, 2020 BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

#### II. DISCUSSION/INFORMATION AGENDA

- A. Dale Scott and Company Financial Advisors
  - 1. Dale Scott was present via Zoom. He presented the Board with election strategy information. Additionally, he reviewed voter strategy and voter turnout from the last election. If we choose not to place the Measure on the November 2020 Ballot, our next opportunity would be the November 2022 election. The Board chose to move forward with one Measure on the November 2020 Ballot.
- B. Reopening Plan for Schools School Year 2020-2021
  - Superintendent met with Dr. Julie Vaishampayan, Stanislaus County Health Officer, and the other County Superintendents, to review a letter we will send to the families regarding the opening of the new school year. Additionally, she distributed the Stanislaus County School Year Planning: A Guide to Addressing the Challenges of COVID-19. This document will be made available via our website to all families. This document details how we will address the upcoming challenges of reopening our schools. Superintendent reminded this document provides guidelines, not absolutes. She also reviewed the revised proposed student attendance calendar and stated that she is working with the Salida Teachers Association on an MOU for the reopening.
- C. Salida Little League Season Reopening at Salida Park
  - 1. The Salida Little League presented the Board with their plans to reopen and resume practices and games under the Stanislaus County Good 2 Go Plan at Salida Park. Because Salida School District leases out the ballpark at Salida Park, the Board is required to approve the reopening. Salida Little League submitted their plans and guidelines to the County and was cleared to resume ball play. After much discussion, the Board approved to allow Salida Little League to open as long as the league adheres to all protocols in place.
- D. Paid Lunch Equity: General Guidance for School Year 2020-2021
  - Superintendent notified the Board that the District opted out of price increase for this year. Paid lunch prices
    will remain the same.

  - 1. Gary Dew stated that he has been very impressed with the food distribution at Salida Elementary. He stated that not only are they distributing food, but the Salida Library is giving out bags with items for students as well. Additionally, on Thursday, Ballico boxes are available full of fresh fruit and vegetables. Dennis Thompson mentioned that the boxes will also include barbeque chicken from Foster Farms. Over 700 boxes are delivered each week. Twila Tosh also reminded everyone that Cradle to Career in partnership with Love our Neighbors is available to help those in need with tutoring, homelessness, education, food, and other help.
  - Dennis Thompson thanked Twila Tosh and staff for working hard to ensure that our students have been given an education during this COVID-19 crisis. He expressed that he feels all staff have done an excellent job in not forgetting the children.




