C. COVID Update

1. Superintendent gave the Board an update on the new CDP K12 and CalOsha guidance. The District has secured antigen test kits for all students and will supply them to any parent that requests a test. One of our parents, Luis Jimenez, sent an email with information on how to order home test kids from the county. We will be placing this information on ParentSquare for families to obtain access to the test kits.

D. 2022-2023 Student Attendance Calendar

- 1. Superintendent informed the Board that the draft calendar was sent to all staff for comment. Two comments were received. The calendar follows Modesto City School's calendar. The calendar will be brought back to the February meeting for action.
- E. Construction Update Sisk Library, Boardroom, and Dena Boer Elementary
 - 1. Superintendent updated the Board on the status of the construction projects at each site. Sisk Library is near completion. There are a few items that need to be signed off, however it will be completed soon. The bids for the Boardroom have been posted and are due by January 24, 2022. Once a contractor is secured, construction will start by summer break. The Board Meetings will be moved to the Salida Middle School Library until the new Boardroom is complete. Dena Boer Elementary is scheduled to have portables 24 through 32 replaced. A new Library with restrooms will replace portables 21 and 22.

F. Superintendent's Report

1. Superintendent updated the board on the new bill to provide additional COVID leave up to 80 hours retroactive to January 1, 2022. Also discussed, new executive order providing greater flexibility for retired employees to return as substitutes before the 6 month waiting period and allows for student teachers to act as substitutes. The Order is good until the end of March, 2022. A Board Member asked if once the staff is hired under this order, will they have to leave at the end of March. Superintendent will research this and respond.
